



- 2. Tighten mount screw to approx 20-25 inch pounds. If desired, low-strength thread locking compound may be used
- 3. Attach the camera mount to the Bar using the 1/4-20 x 3/8" screw provided as shown. Use a straight-bladed screwdriver or a coin to tighten the screw firmly.

NOTE: The camera mount can be installed in either direction based on which side of the rifle the Bar will be placed.



#### **ADJUSTING THE TENSION SCREW:**

There may be a slight amount of movement between the Pic Rail Mount and the Bar. While this will not affect the video quality, the movement can be easily removed by adjusting the nylon-tipped tension screw with the provided 2mm hex wrench.

- I. Remove the Pic Rail Mount from the gun and assemble it with the Bar as shown.
- 2. Use the provided wrench to lightly tighten the tension screw against the Bar. Make sure that the Bar can still be removed and installed on the Mount. (A light coating of grease between the Mount and Bar may be desired)
- 3. Replace the Mount on the Picatinny rail and firmly tighten with the provided T15 wrench.



NOTE: The nylon tip on the screw may wear slightly over time. If this occurs, simply remove the mount and readjust it.

**NOTE:** The screw is captured when the Bar is installed. However, excessive shooting without the Bar installed could cause the screw to vibrate loose. To prevent this, a low-strength thread-locking adhesive can be used. If the screw is lost, it may be replaced by any M4x0.7 nylon-tipped set screw.

#### **INSTALL CAMERA ONTO MOUNT**

- I. Install the camera into the mount by removing the thumbscrew and aligning the camera bracket into the slots on the mount.
- 2. Replace the thumbscrew and tighten it hand tight only to lock the Camera into position.

#### INSTALL CAMERA ADAPTER ONTO PIC RAIL MOUNT

- 1. With the camera attached to the Bar, slide the end of the bar onto the Pic Rail Mount as shown.
- 2. There are two spring detents that prevent the Bar from coming off in use. Slide the Bar onto the mount until you feel these detents "snap" into place. The adapter can be quickly and easily removed by simply pulling the Bar off the mount.
